The KP Network provides high school students with IEP/504 plans ages 14-24 with preemployment transition services (PRE-ETS) to better prepare them for independent living and a career of their choosing. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) amended the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and now requires vocational rehabilitation (VR) agencies provide PRE-ETS to Students Disabilities who are eligible or potentially eligible for VR services. PRE-ETS includes the following services:

- Job exploration counseling
- Work-based learning experiences, which may include in-school or after school opportunities, experiences outside of the traditional school setting, and/or internships
- Counseling on opportunities for enrollment in comprehensive transition or postsecondary educational programs
- Workplace readiness training to develop social skills and independent living
- Instruction in self-advocacy

Eligible students face several barriers in accessing PRE-ETS that include transportation, lack of knowledge, lack of access in rural communities or a trusted advocate. The KP Network collaborates to provide high quality programming at local high schools as a first step in ensuring that all students have the opportunity to "go pro" (#everyonecangopro). The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) sets aside federal funds to provide PRE-ETS to Students with Disabilities.
